

HealthMAP User Instructions

WiRED International offers hundreds of health education modules designed to help individuals learn essential and advanced healthcare topics. These modules also prepare students to take and pass WiRED's comprehensive final exam to become certified WiRED International Community Health Workers.

To earn and maintain certification, all students and current Community Health Workers are required to submit quiz and final exam scores to their instructors or program managers.

Our mobile app, HealthMAP, makes it easy to meet these requirements. Below is a step-by-step guide to help you take full advantage of HealthMAP's features.

A. Download and Study Health Modules

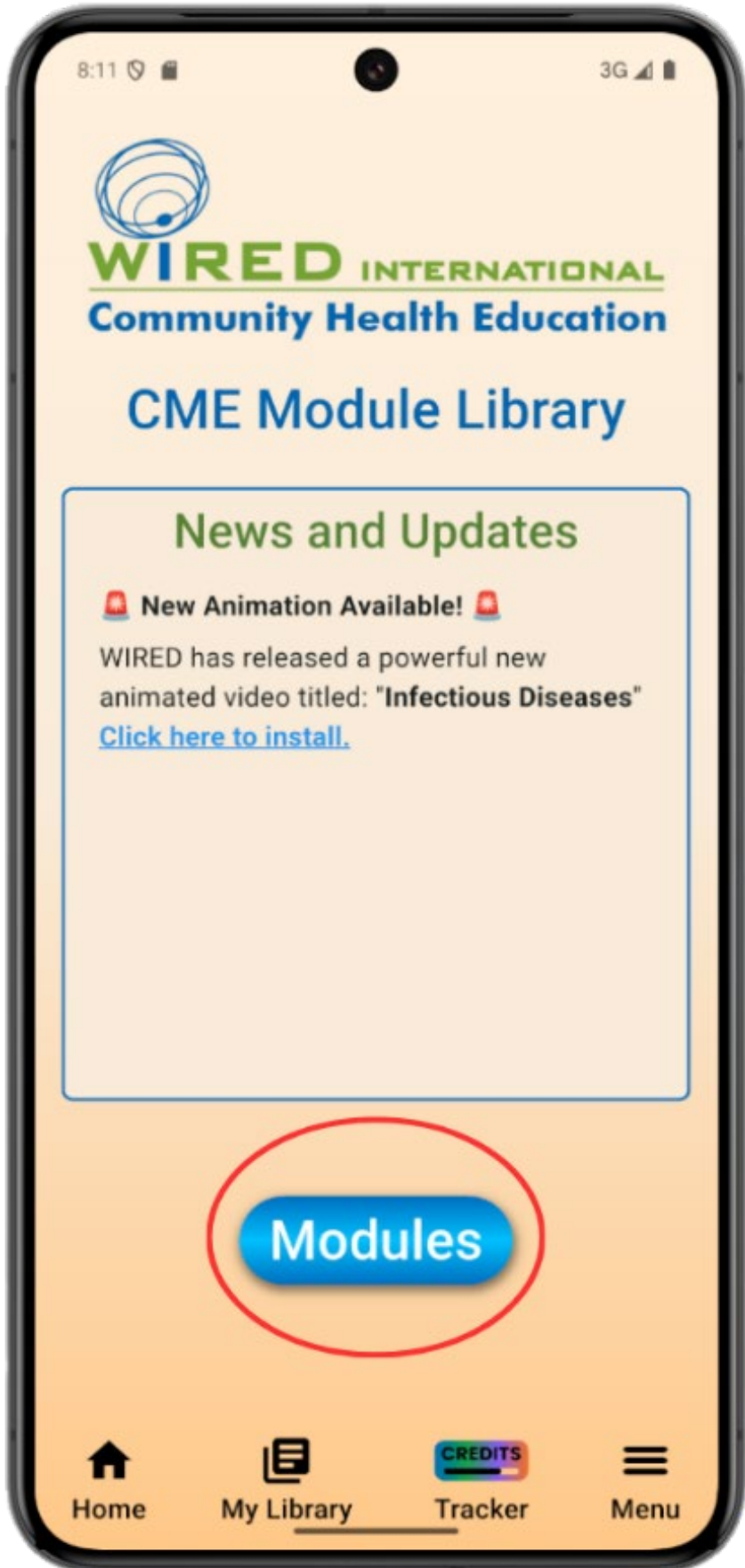

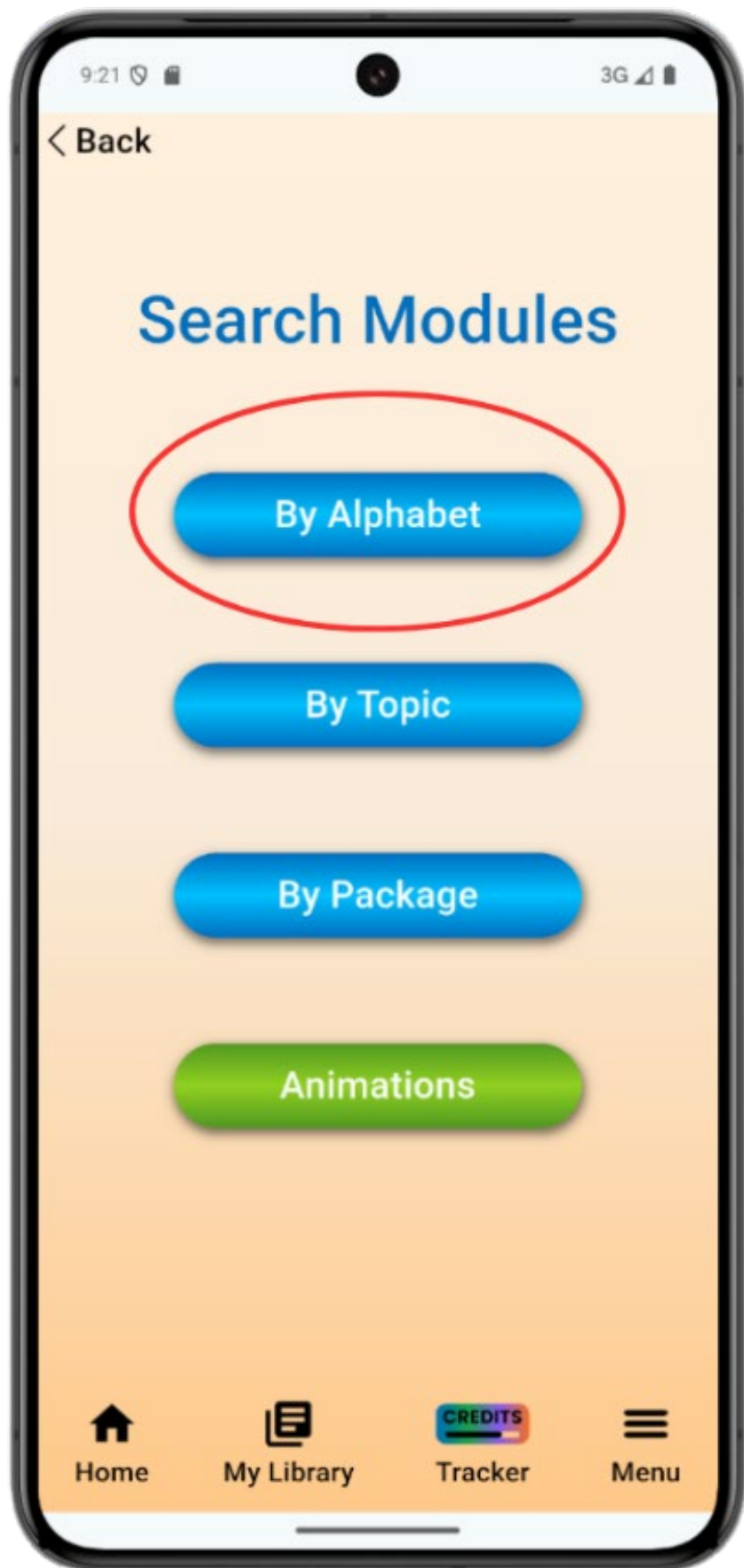
Step 1 - [Navigate to Modules](#)

Once the HealthMAP app has been installed, open the app. You will see this homepage. Tap the “Modules” button to begin a search for health modules.

Step 2 – Search module by alphabet

Tap on the “By Alphabet” button to search for WiRED’s health modules by alphabet.

Select a letter to search for modules listed under that letter.



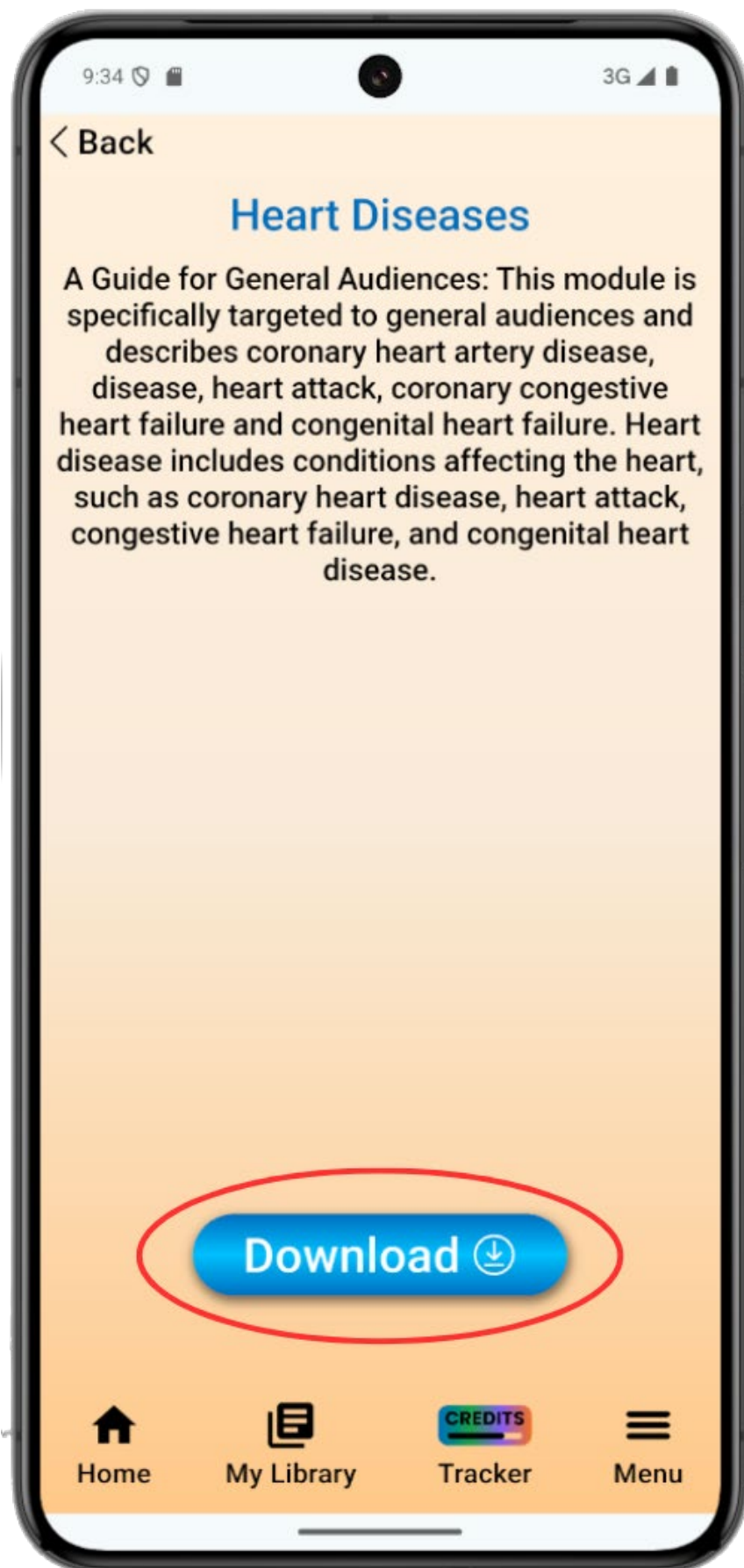


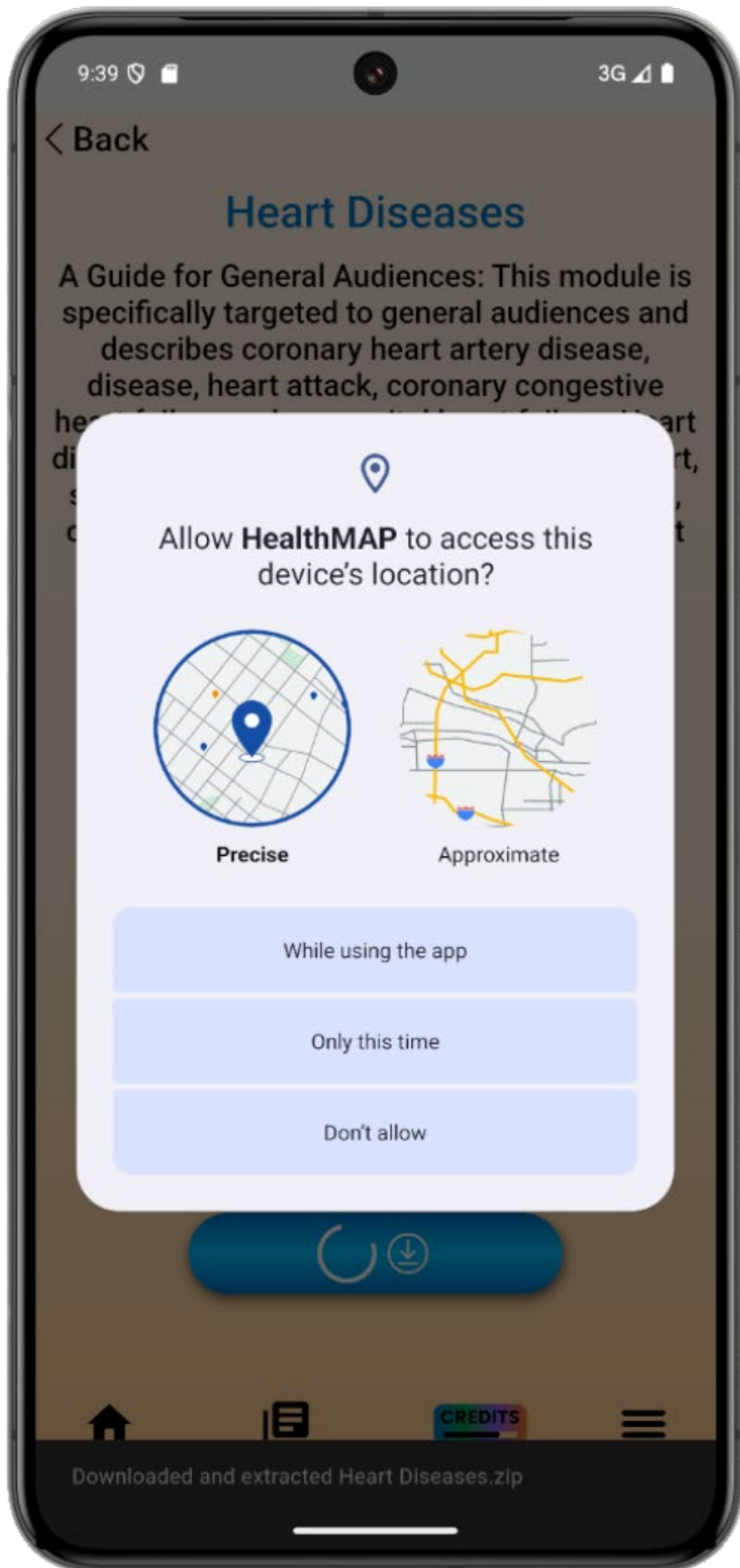
Step 3 – Select Module (Internet connection required)

Scroll through the list of health modules and tap on the desired module for download.

Step 4 – [Begin Download \(Internet connection required\)](#)

Read the module description to make sure the correct health modules was selected. If the correct module was selected, tap on the “Download” button to begin the download process.





Step 5 – [Optional Location Tracking](#)

Before the download completes, please choose whether to allow WiRED International to track your phone's location during downloads.

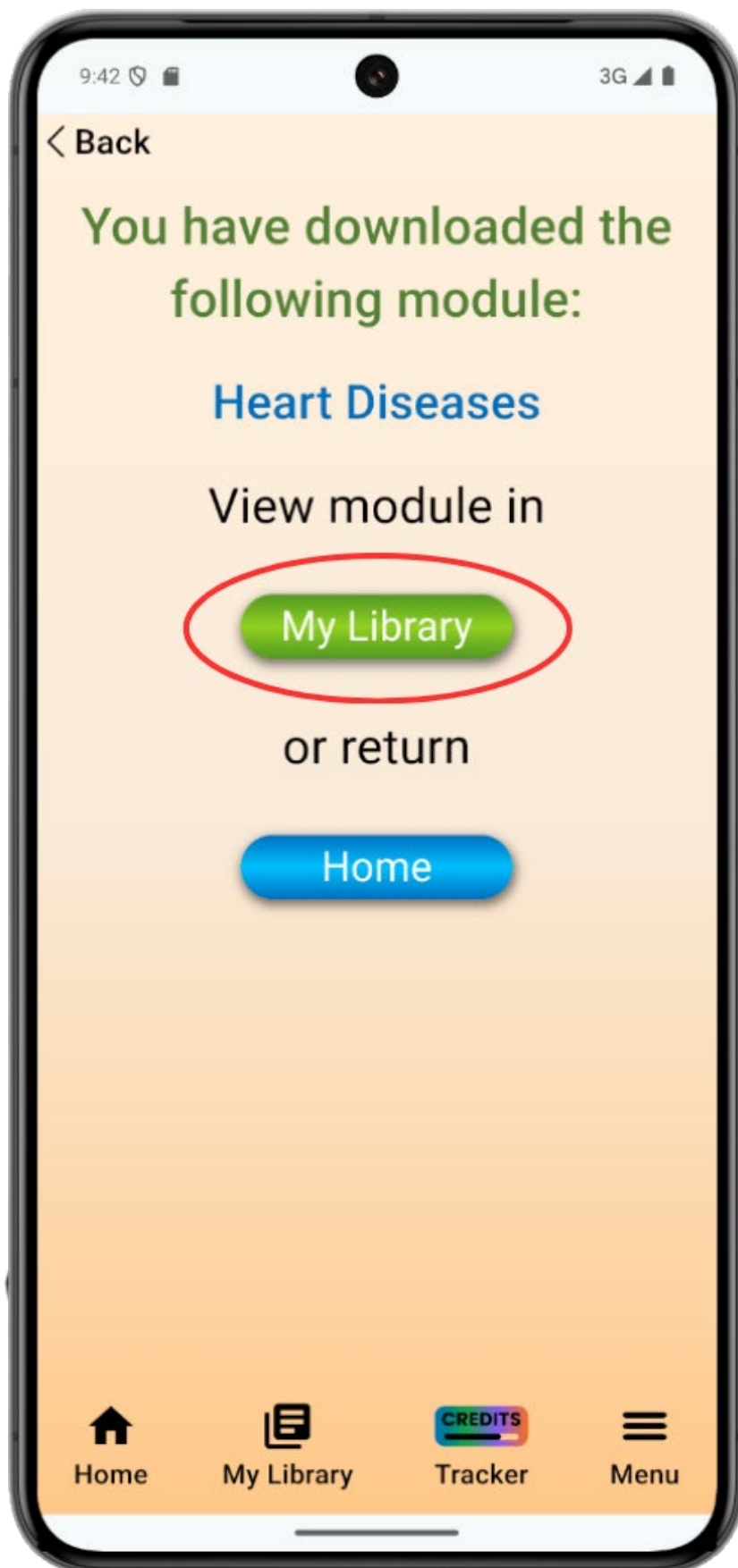
We do **NOT** collect any personal information. Our goal is simply to understand which health module topics are being accessed in specific regions.

The data we collect is **anonymous** and used solely to help improve our programs and better prevent the spread of infectious diseases.

Step 6 – [Navigate to Library](#)

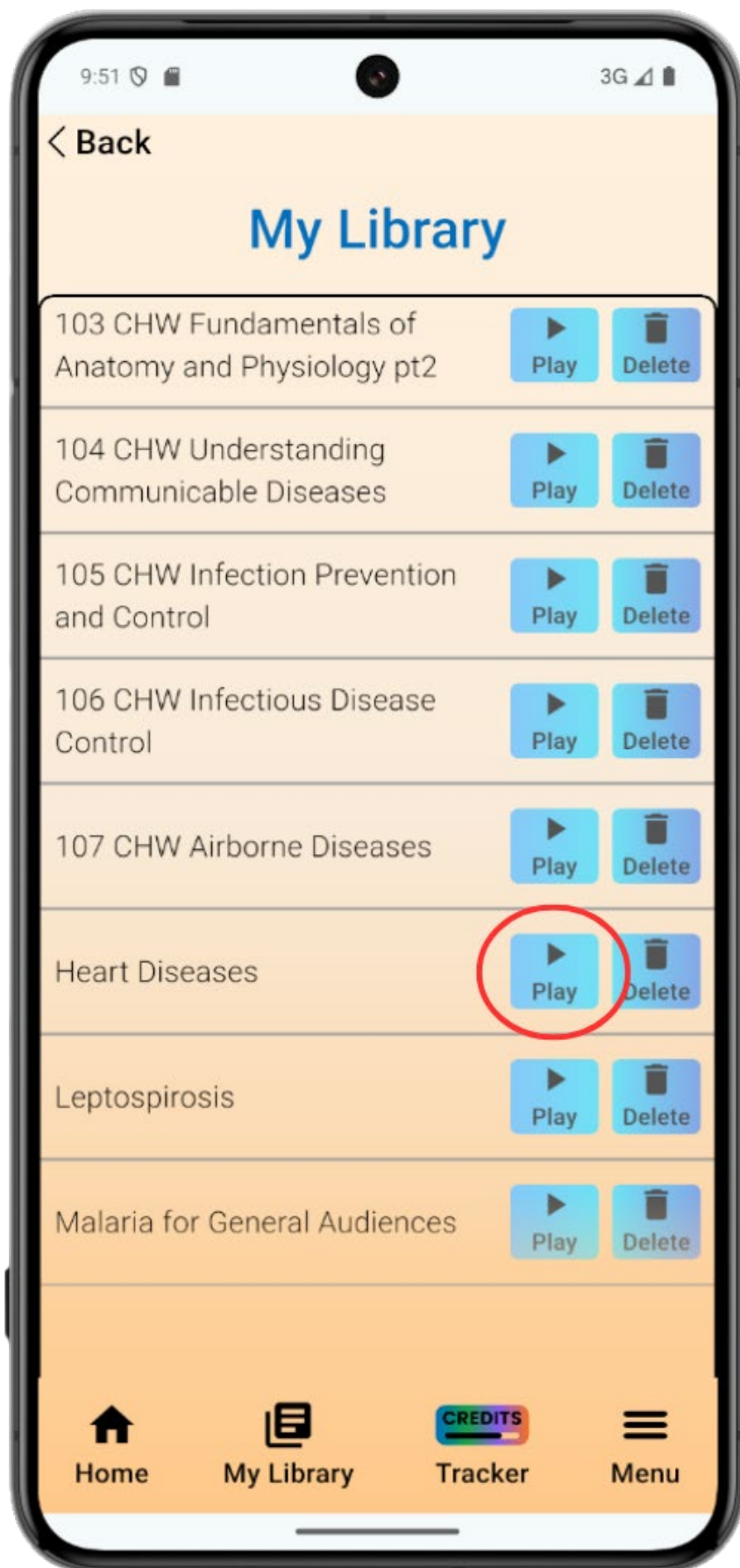
Once the download completes, view the downloaded module from the library page.

Tap on “My Library” to navigate to the library page. The library page can always be accessed from the “My Library” icon at the bottom the navigation bar.



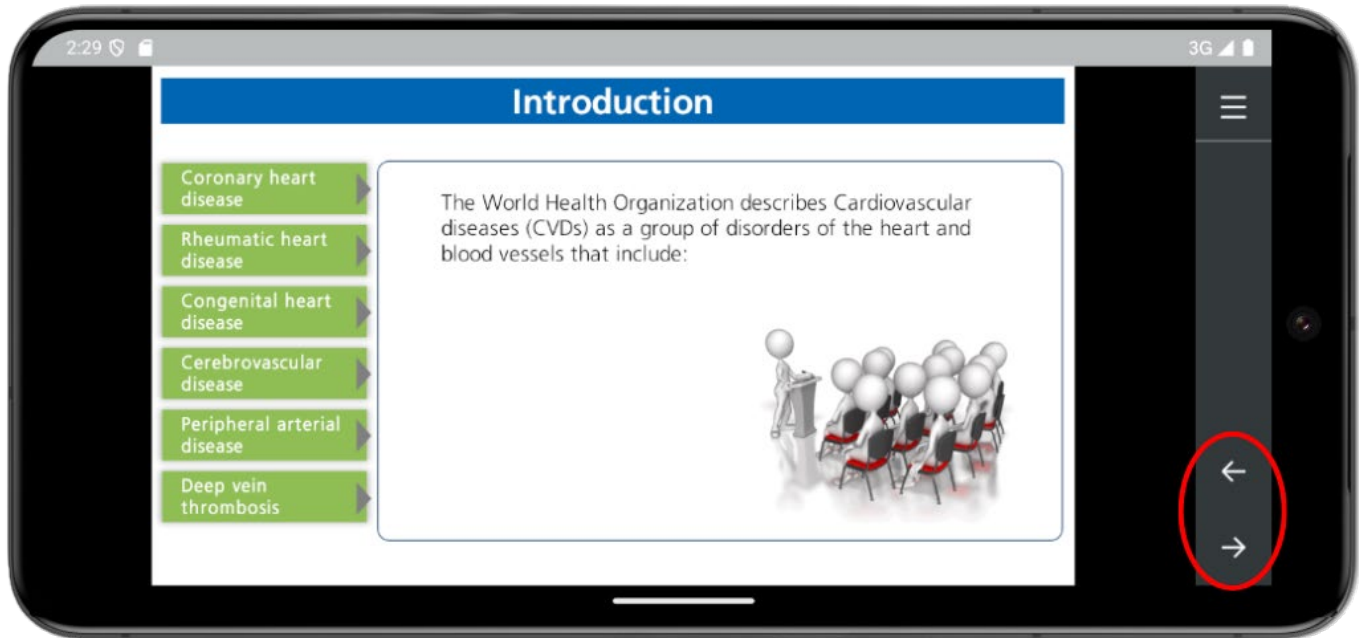
Step 7 – Play Module (Internet Connection Not Required)

Scroll and search through the library to find the desired module. Tap on the “Play” button to begin the module.



Step 8 – Study Module (Internet Connection Not Required)

The health module is best view in landscape mode. Turn the phone horizontally while studying the health module. Use the arrow icons on the lower right screen to navigate through the module.

B. Quiz Score Submissions

To become a certified WiRED Community Health Worker, one of the requirements is for students to complete and pass the final quiz found in each module from the CHW Basic Training list. Note the students must complete other requirements, as well. Contact WiRED for details (inquiry@wiredinternational.org). Once certified, community health workers are required to continue their education by submitting Continuing Medical Education (CME) credits annually. This ongoing learning process aligns with global standards in healthcare and reflects requirements recommended by the World Health Organization for community health workers.

Submitting final quiz scores for the Basic Training requirement or for annual CME credits on HealthMAP is a simple process. All downloaded health modules can still be viewed and completed offline. All final quiz scores at the end of a module can be stored securely on the user's phone while the user is offline. An internet connection is necessary for the actual scores to be submitted to the user's account online. The scores do not count as credit until the score have been successfully submitted online.

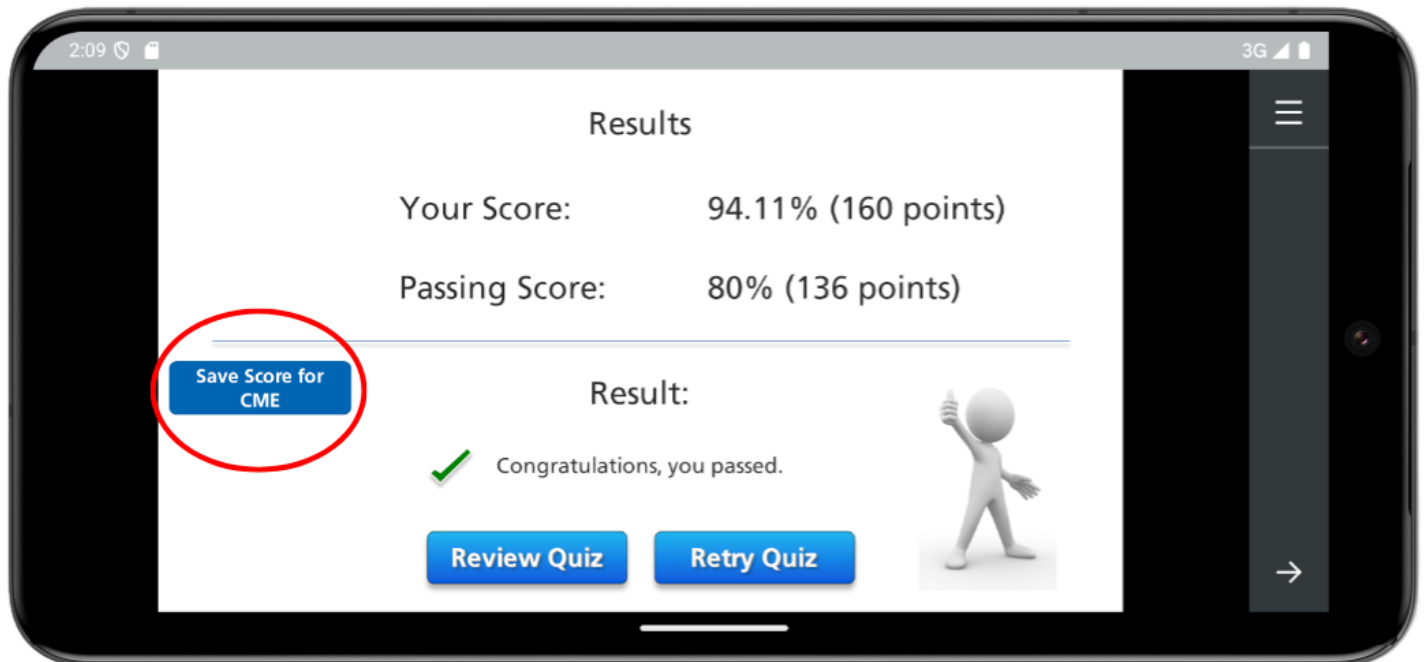
Here is a step-by-step guide on how to fully utilize WiRED's new Credit Tracker on HealthMAP.

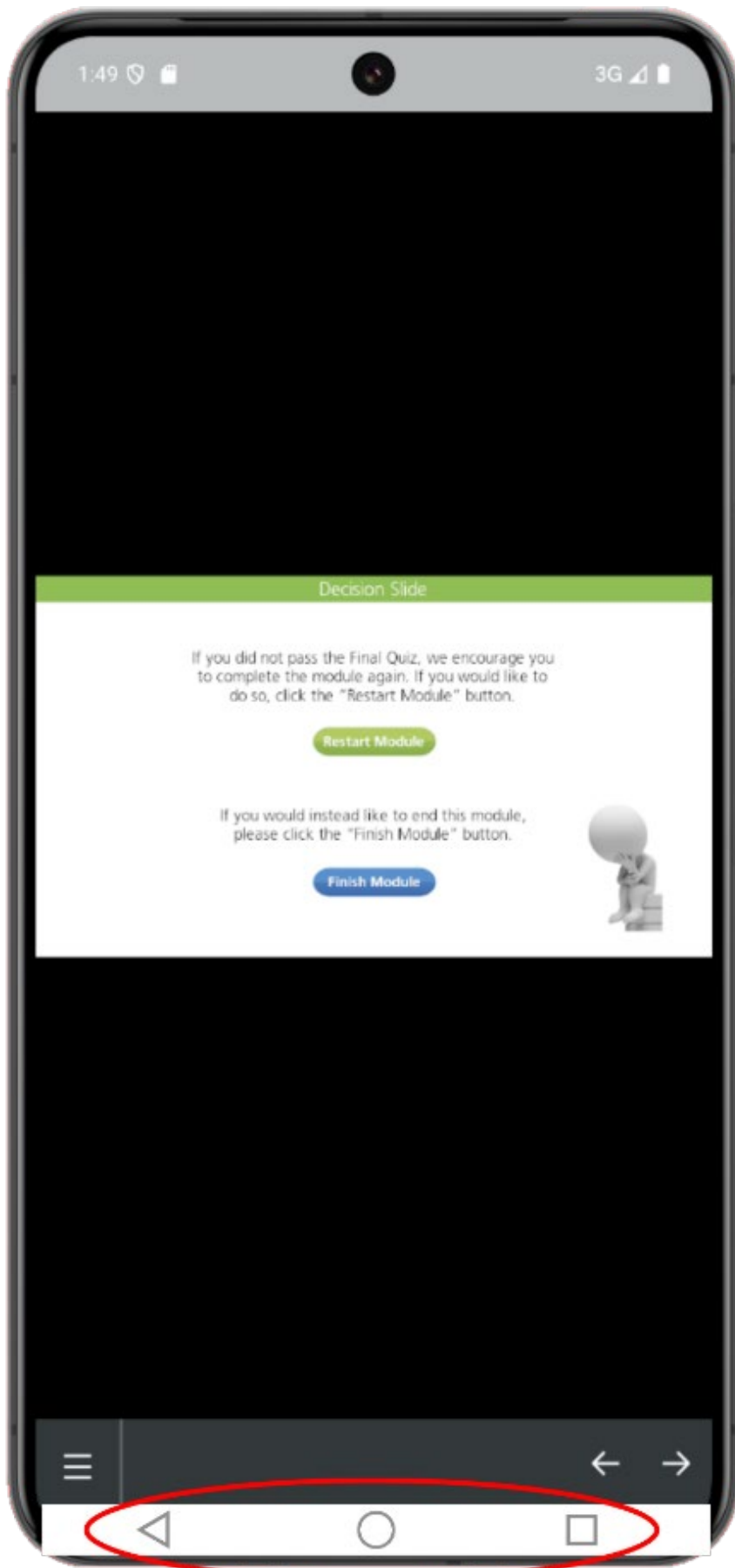
Step 1 – Save Quiz Score (Internet Connection Not Required)

Study a health module and take the final quiz at the end of that module. At the end of the final quiz, a button on the left side of the screen will be displayed with the text, “Save Score for CME”.

Tap on the “Save Score for CME” button to save the score for submission later when internet connection is available. If a user retakes the quiz and earns a higher score, pressing the “Save Score for CME” button will replace the old score with the new score. Scores for multiple health modules can be stored in the user’s phone for CME credit submission later. The Basic Training modules will also say “Save Score for CME” at the end of the quiz, but all Basic Training modules will NOT count as CME credit. Passing scores for the Basic Training module quizzes are required for CHW certification.

Note that saving the final quiz score does not mean it has been officially submitted yet to WiRED International.



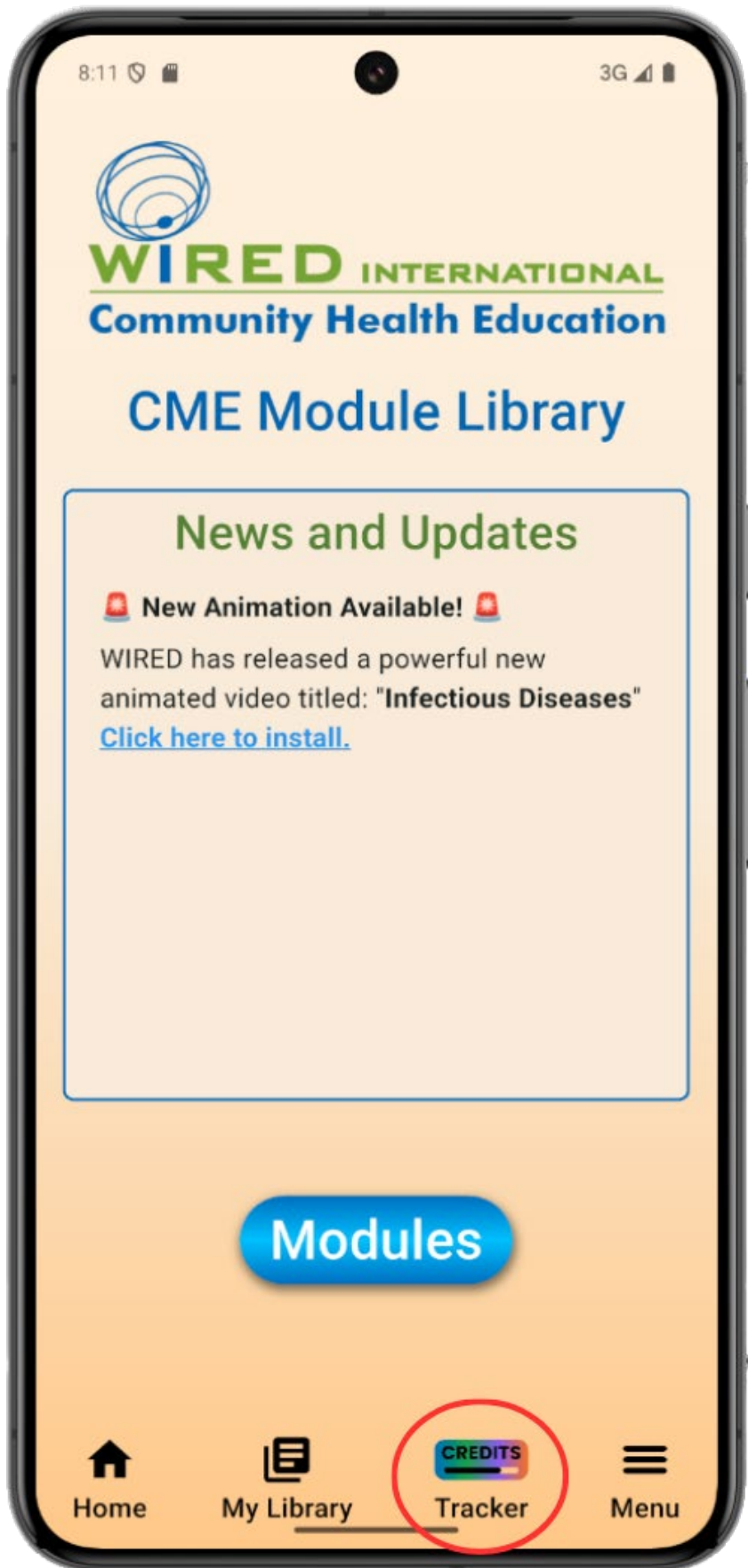


Step 1 - [Continued](#)

Once the quiz score has been saved, return the phone back to portrait mode by turning the phone to the vertical position.

Exit the module by using the Android navigation bar at the very bottom of the screen.

If the navigation bar is not visible, swipe down from the very top of the screen. The navigation bar at the bottom should appear.

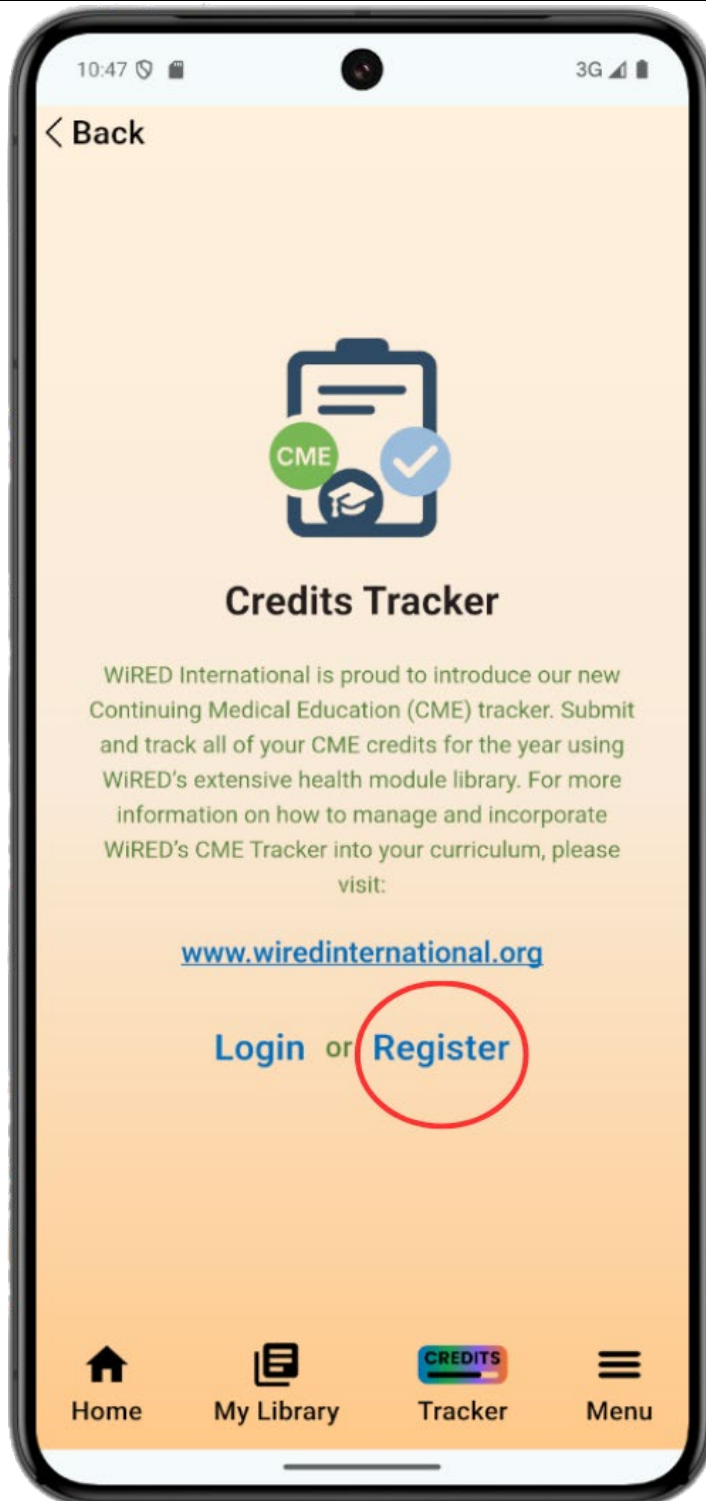


Step 2 – Register Account with WIRED (Internet Connection Required)

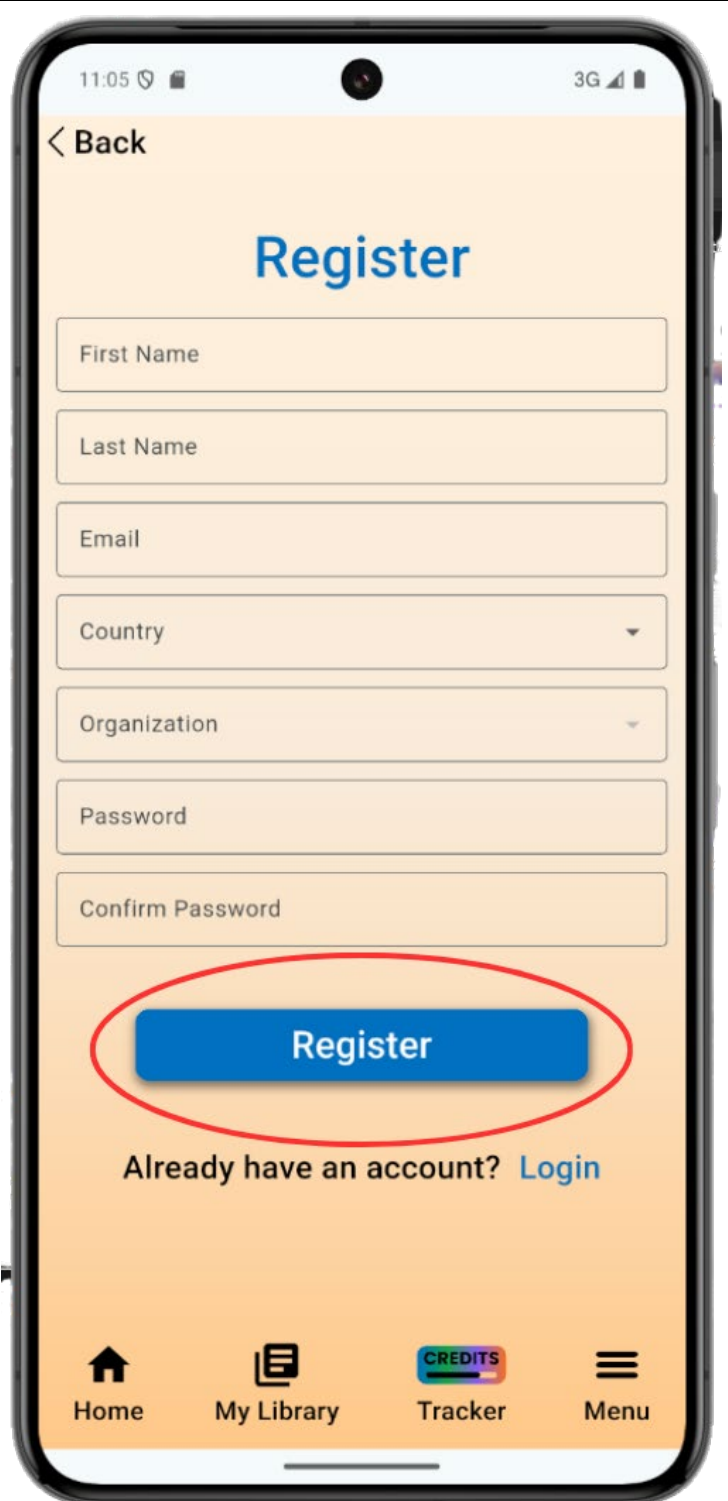
Tap on the Credits Tracker icon located at the bottom of the screen. If you already have an account with WIRED, skip to the step 3. Otherwise, please register with WIRED in order to submit and receive score credit.

Step 2 – Continued (Internet Connection Required)

Tap on the “Register” button, fill out the form, and tap on “Register” once more to submit the form. Be sure to fill out all the fields before submitting. Once the registration is complete, continue to the next step to login.



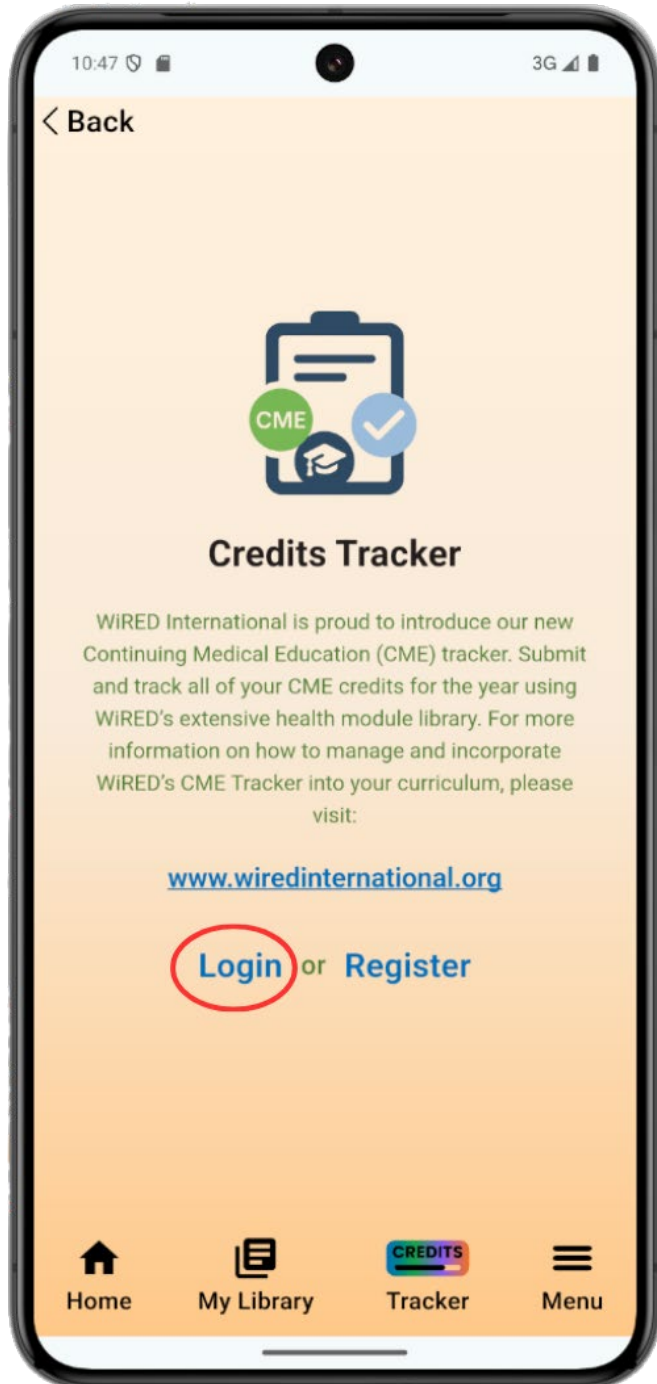

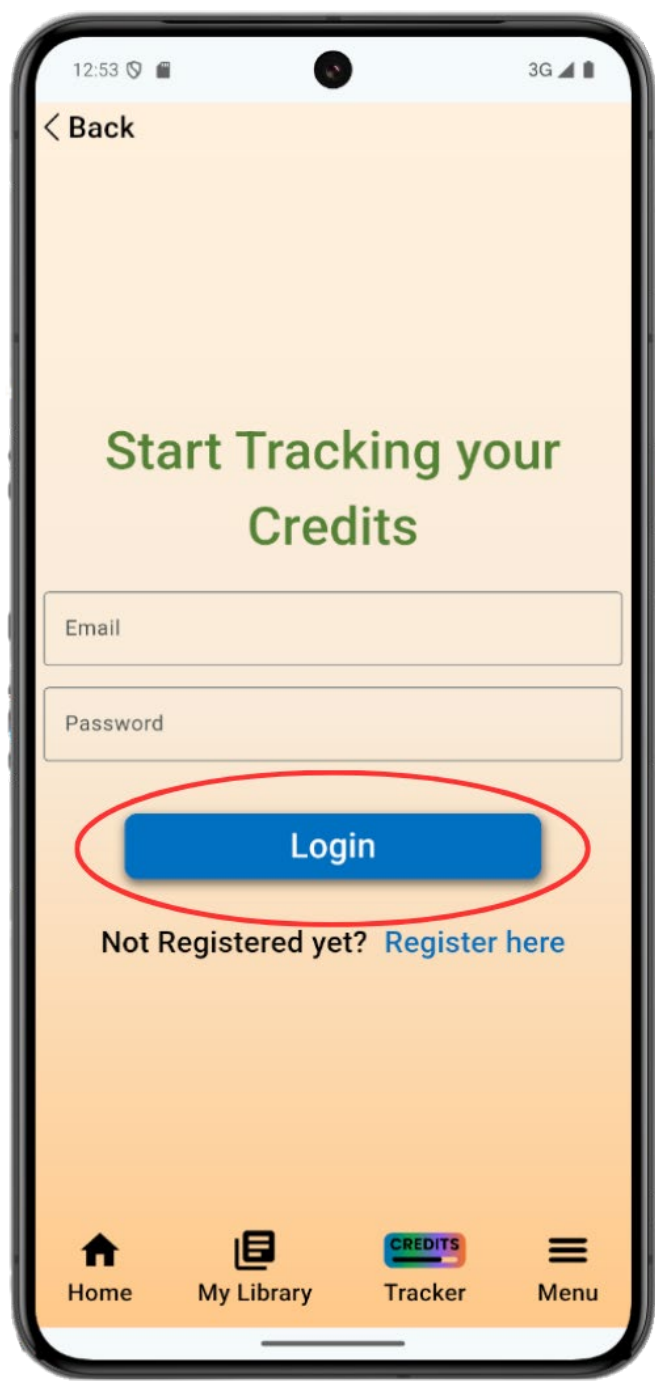

Step 3 – Login to CME Tracker (Internet Connection Required)

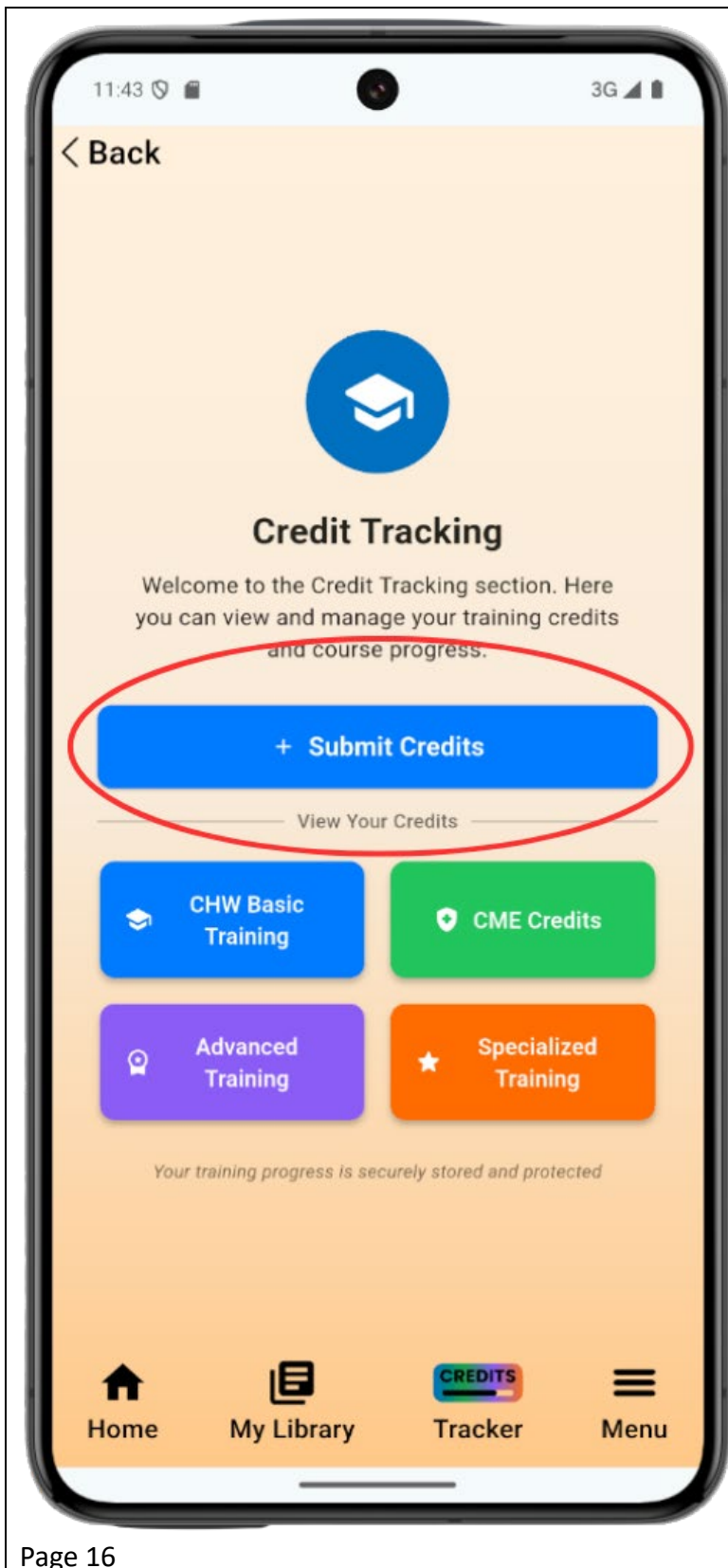
Login to the Credits Tracker by tapping on the “Login” button. Fill in the necessary information to login and access the Credits Tracker page.

Step 4 – [Submit New Score for Basic Training Credit \(Internet Connection Required\)](#)

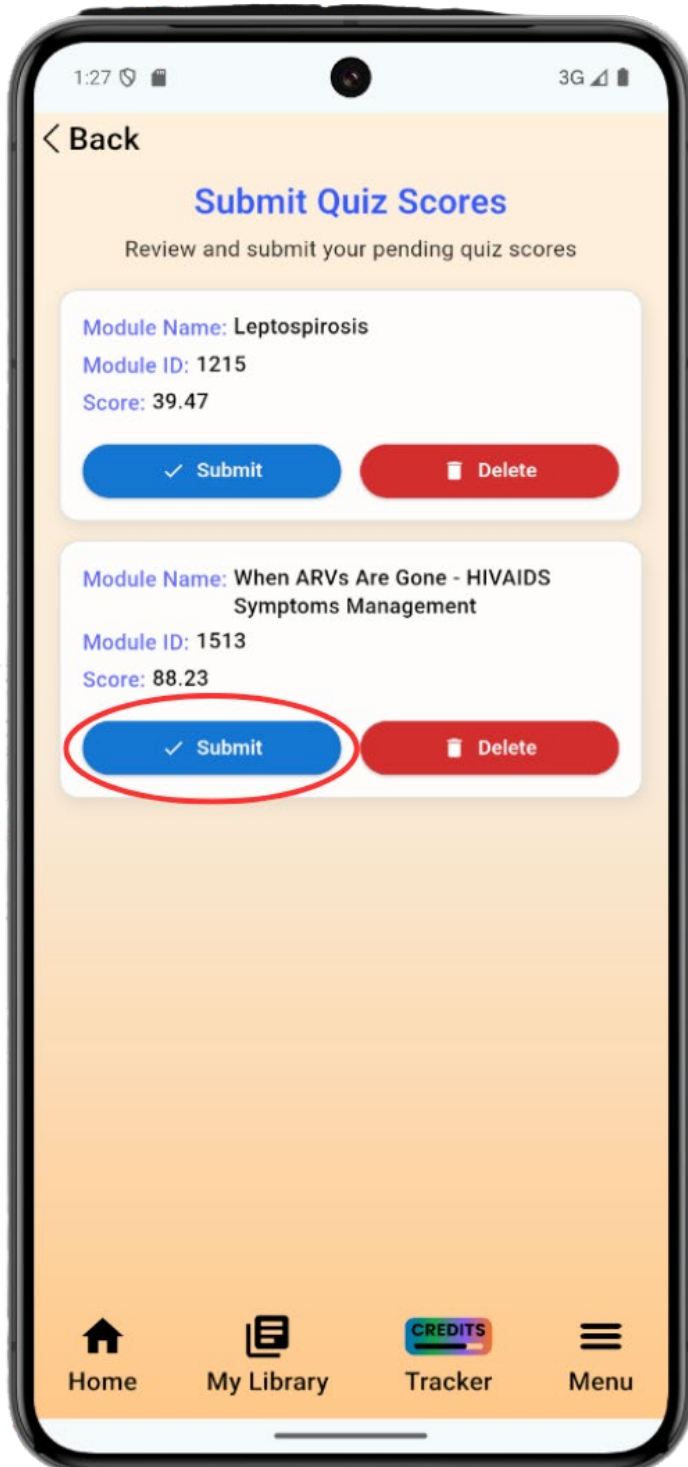
The Credits Tracker page provides access to submit saved quiz scores from the modules and to view all scores successfully submitted.

Simply tap on the Submit Credits button to begin officially submitting saved quiz scores.

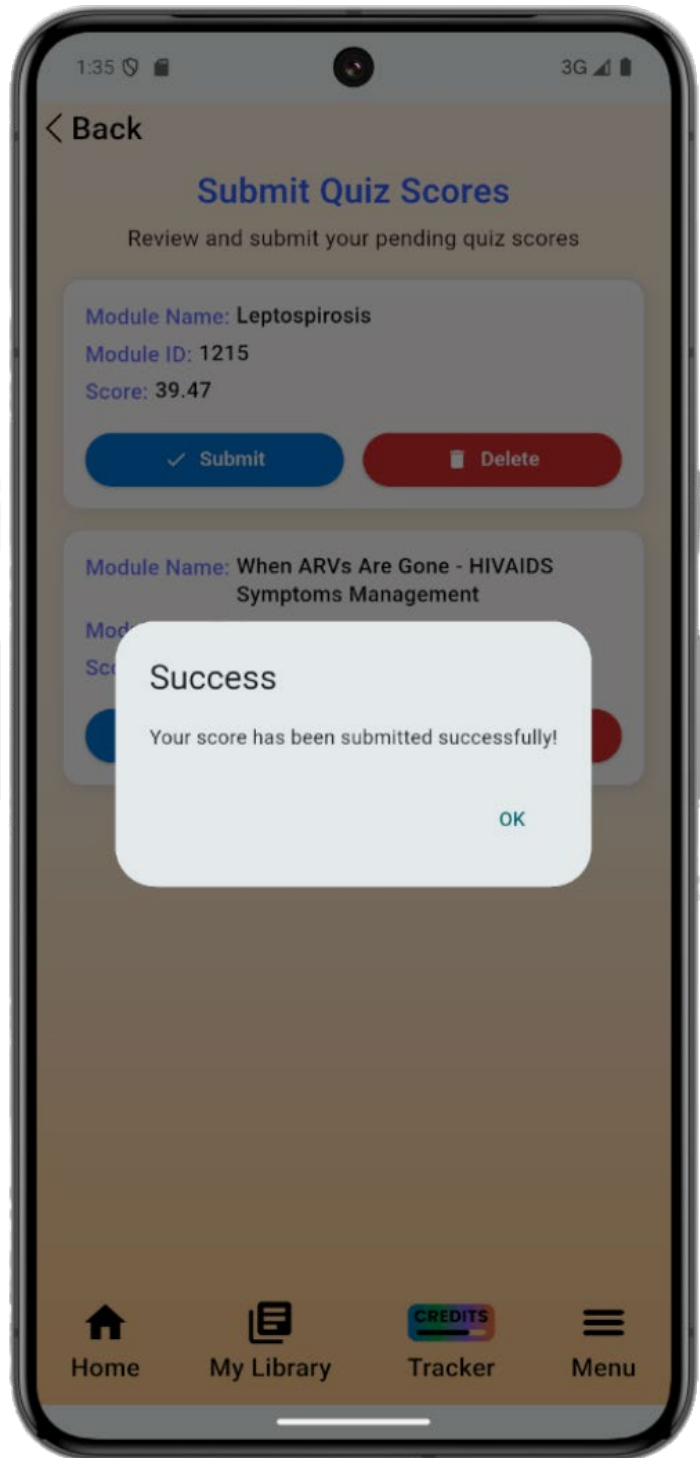
Step 4 – Continued (Internet Connection Required)

Locate the module name and the associated score for credit submission, and tap on the “Submit” button to officially submit new credits. An alert will appear if the submission was successful.

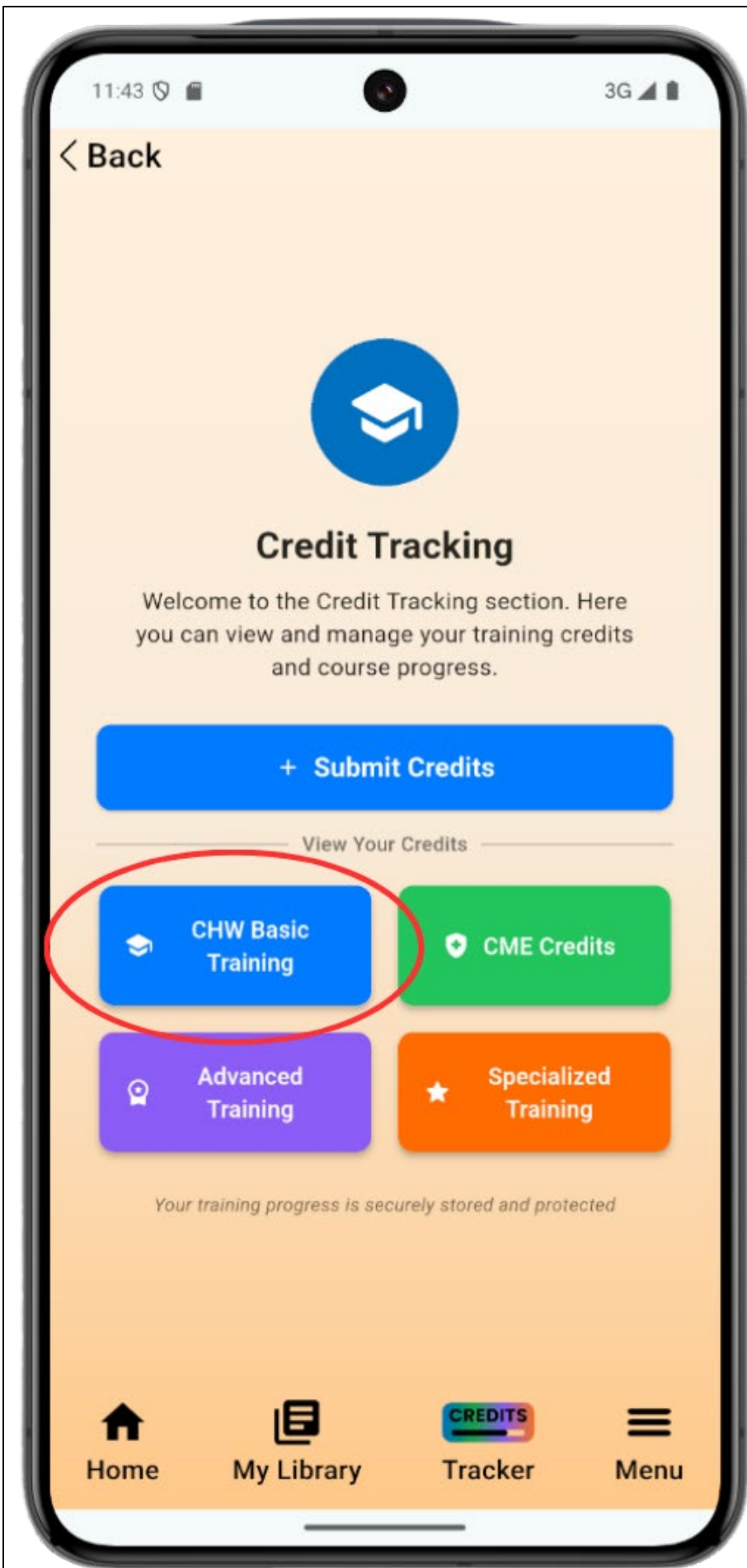
Only scores of 80.00% or higher will count as credit. Feel free to retake the final quiz to earn a higher score. Tapping the “Delete” button will remove the saved score from the phone, so the user can keep their phone free from unnecessary clutter. Tapping the “Delete” button will not remove the score from WiRED’s database.

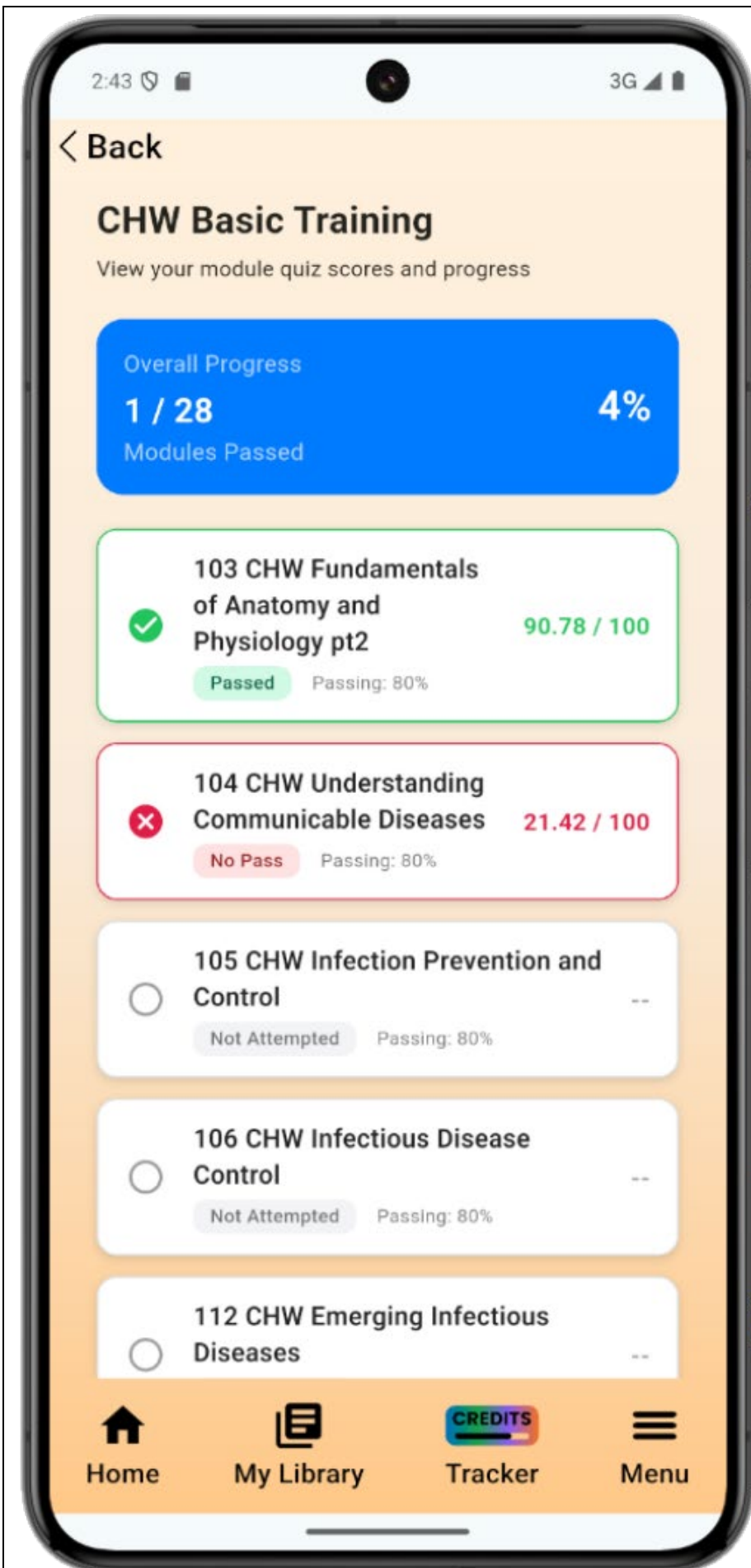


Step 5a – Track Basic Training credits (Internet Connection Required)

All credit types such as Basic Training credit, CME credit, Advanced training credit, and Specialized Training credit can be easily tracked on HealthMAP. A passing score of 80% or above is required for all quizzes of each credit type.

Navigate to the Credit Tracking page. Tap on the CHW Basic Training button to begin tracking all earned credit for Basic training.

Once again, all final quizzes from the Basic Training modules must be completed with a passing scoring in order to earn WiRED's CHW certificate.

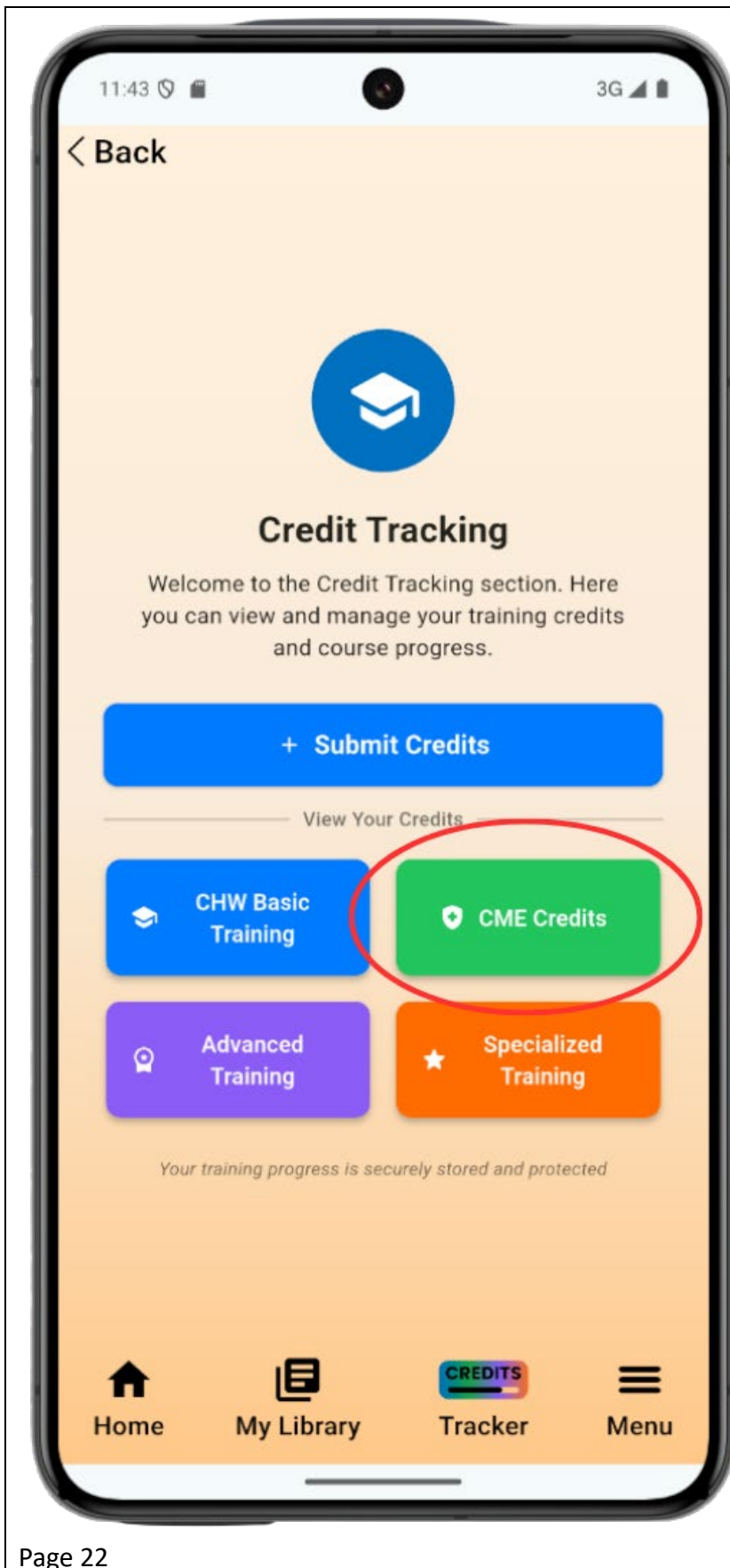


Step 5b – Track Basic Training credits (Internet Connection Required)

The CHW Basic Training page lists all required quizzes that must be completed with a satisfactory score of at least 80% or above.

Quizzes with passing scores will be marked with green. Quizzes with scores below 80% will be marked in red. Scores that have not been attempted will remain unmarked.

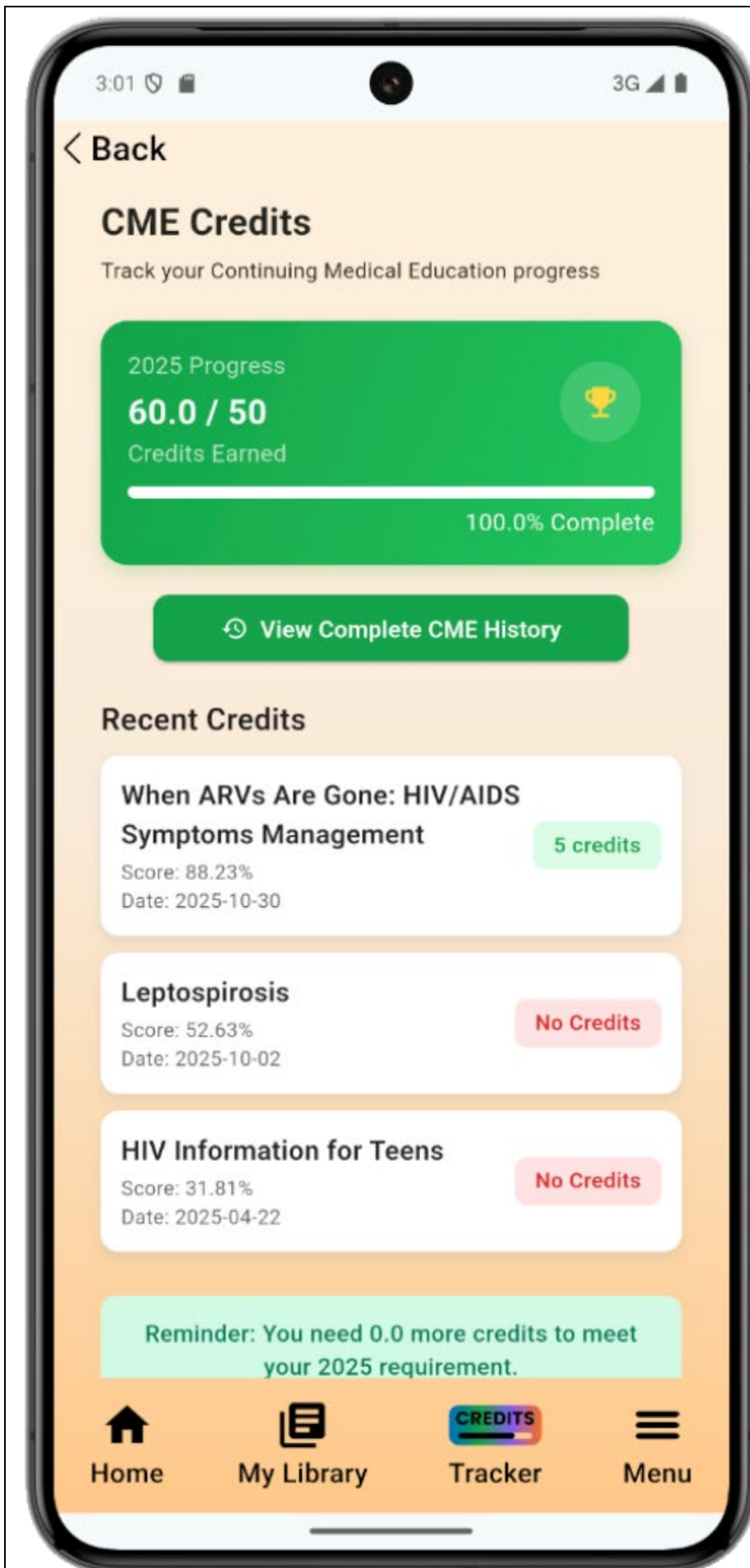
Scroll down to view all necessary quizzes to fulfill one of the Basic Training requirements. Use this page as a personal checklist.



Step 6a – [Track CME Credits](#) (Internet Connection Required)

Navigate to the Credit Tracking page. Tap on the “CME Credits” button to access the CME tracker page.

This page will be used regularly, especially after receiving certification, to track all required CME submissions for the year.



Step 6b – [Track CME Credits](#) ([Internet Connection Required](#))


The CME Credits Tracker page displays how many CME credits have been earned so far, as well as how many more are needed before the end of the year. Note that 50 CME credits are required annually to fulfill CME requirements and to maintain CHW certification with WiRED.

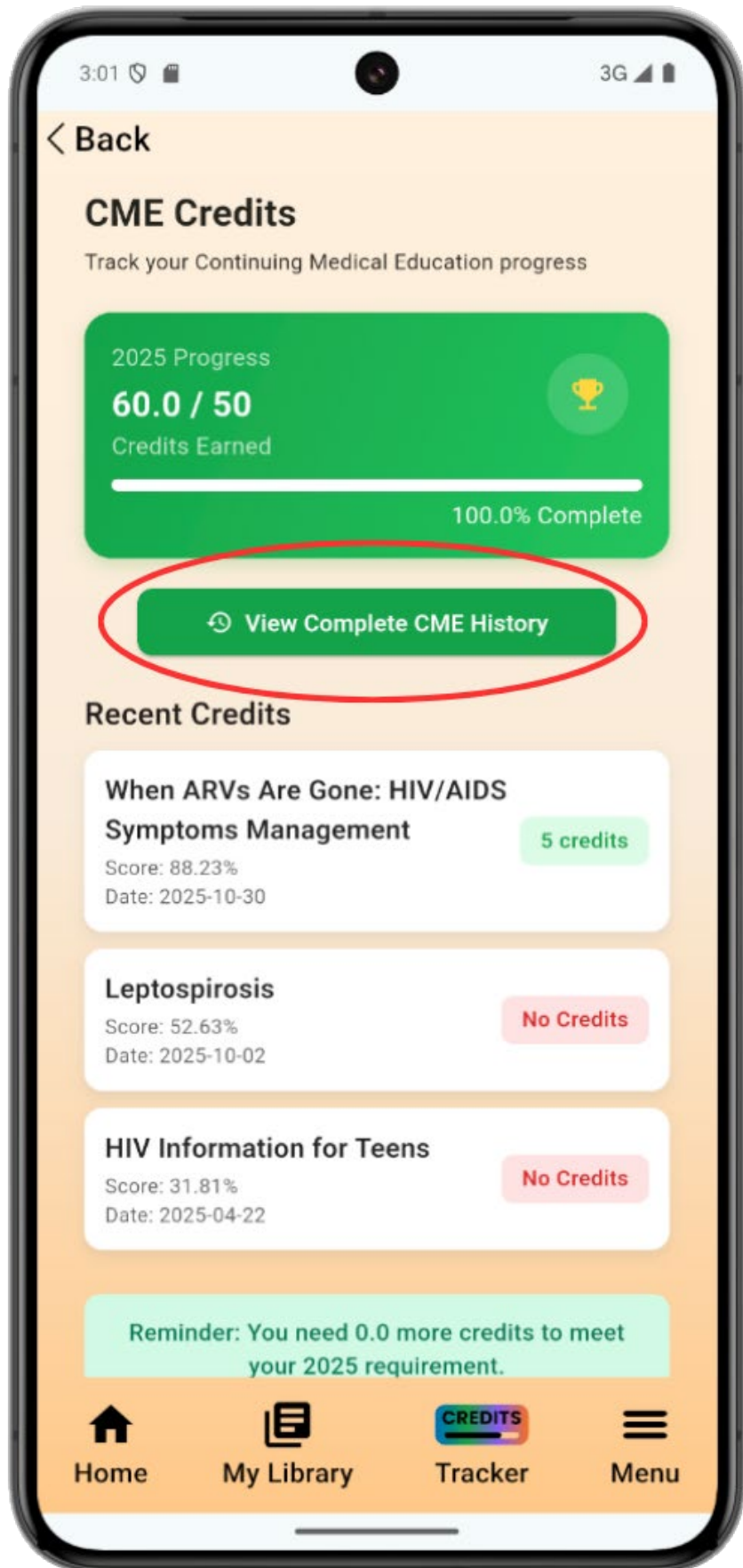
All submitted CME credits can be viewed by tapping on the “View Complete CME History” button.

The most recent CME credit submission will be listed under “Recent Credits.”

C. CME Credit History Emailing Instructions

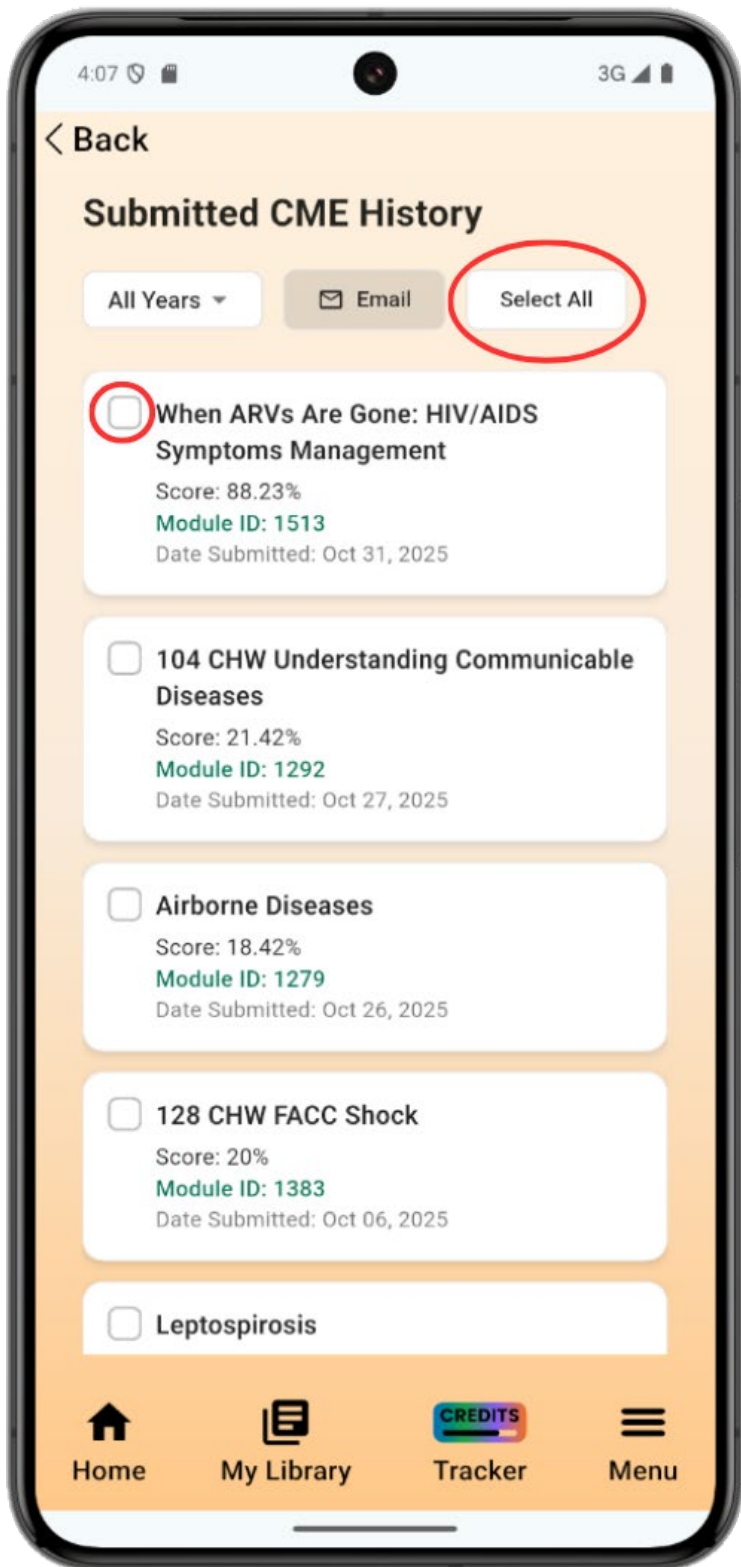
All registered users can easily share their CME credit history by email with their manager or health officials. An internet connection will be necessary; be sure to login to CME Tracker first. Here is a step-by-step guide to send the entire CME credit history to a recipient.

Step 2 - [Navigate to Complete CME History \(Internet Connection Require\)](#)

Tap on the “View Complete CME History” button to navigate to the CME history page.



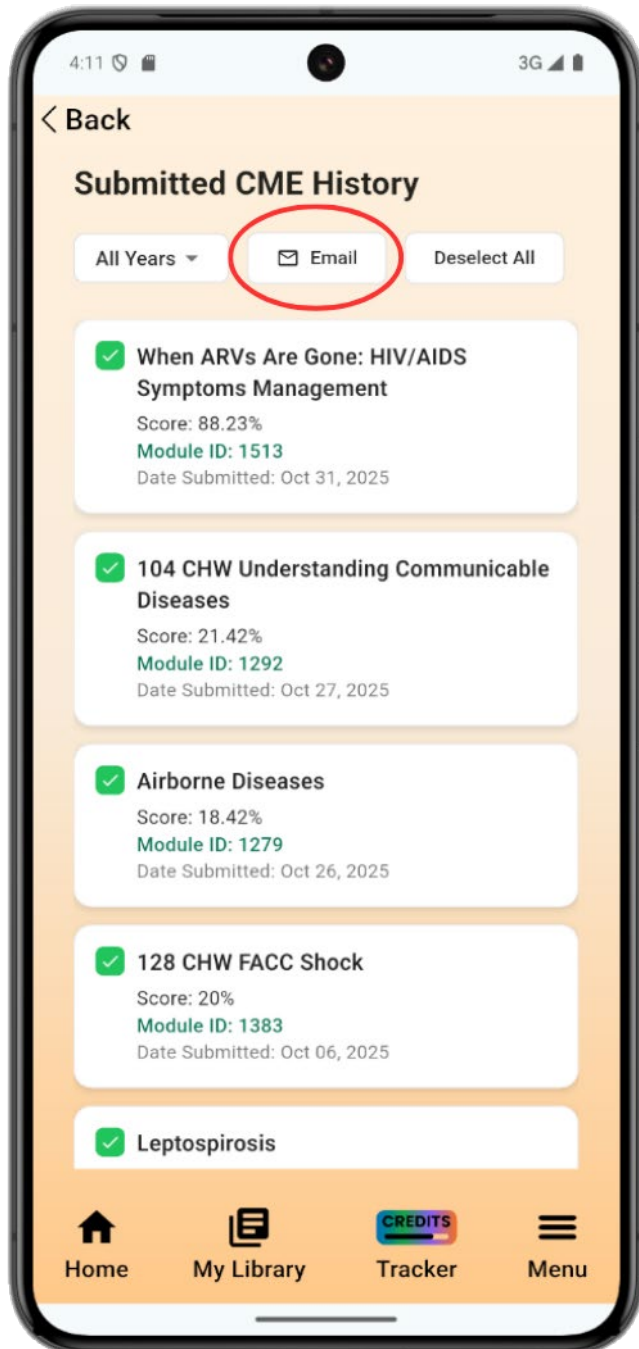
Step 3 – Select credits to email (Internet Connection Require)

All submitted CME credits can be viewed, or credits can be viewed by each year from the dropdown menu on the top left.

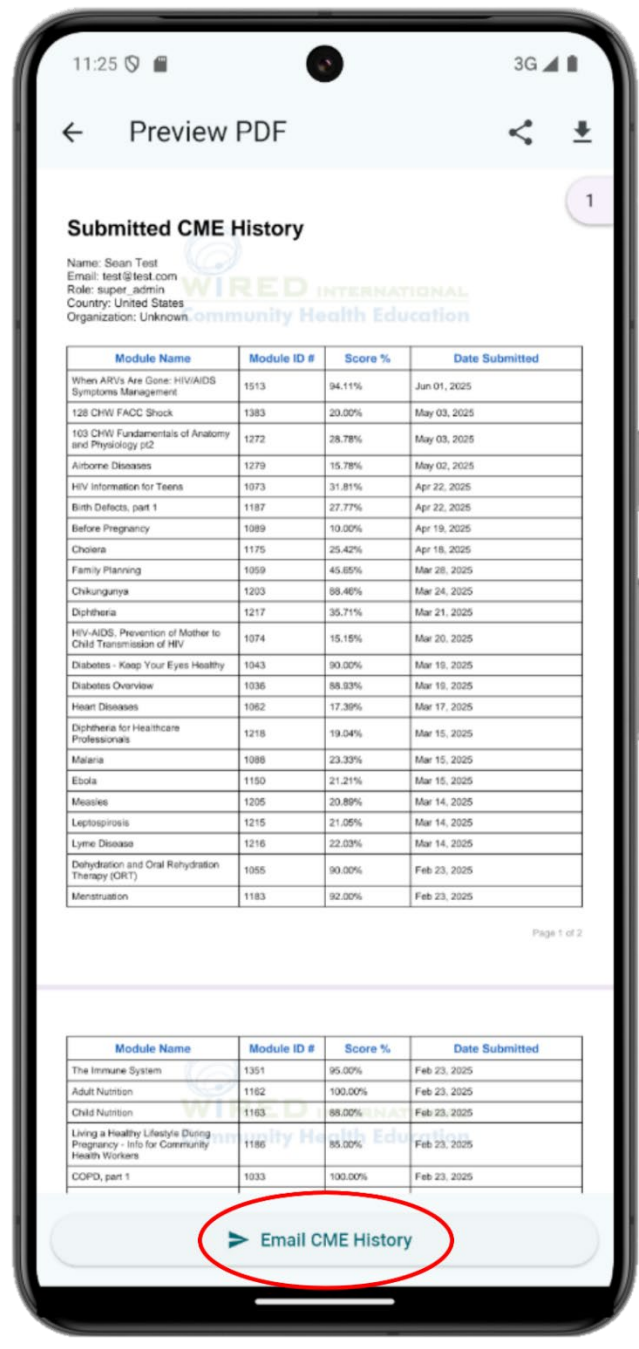
All visible credits can be selected by tapping on the “Select All” button. Individual credits can be selected by tapping on the square located at the right of the screen. At least one module with a quiz score must be selected before sending an email.

Step 4 - Select CME credit and view document (Internet Connection Required)

Once the desired CME credits are selected, tap on the “Email” button at the top. A preview of the CME credits history document will appear. Tap on the “Email CME History” button at the very bottom. Be sure to have the phone upright like in the example below when tapping on the “Email CME History” button.

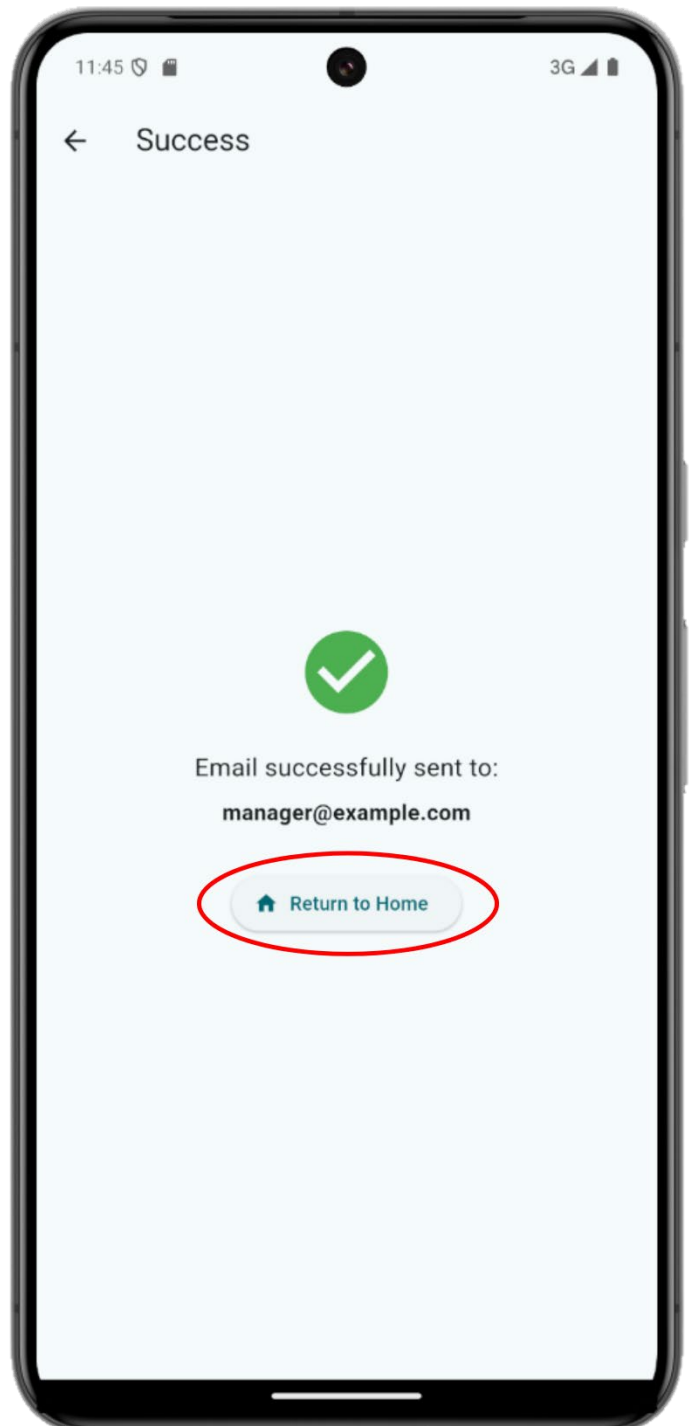
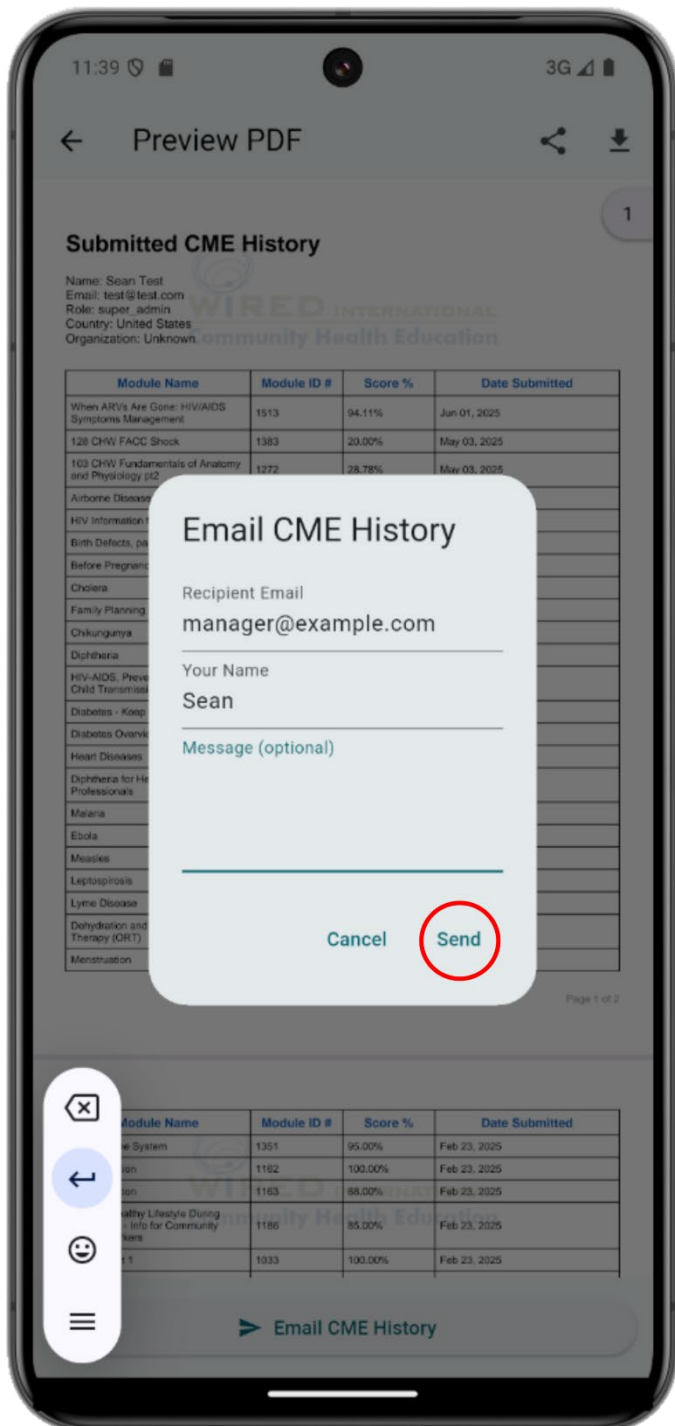

Step 5 – Send Email (Internet Connection Required)

After tapping the “Email CME History” button, a prompt should appear. Enter the email address of the person receiving the document in the top field. Make sure the correct address is entered! Add your name in the next field below. A message to the receiver is optional. Click the “Send” button to deliver the email.

A confirmation page should appear. The confirmation page does not ensure that the entered email address was correct. Make sure to enter the correct email address. Tap on the “Return to Home” button to return home.
